DAY 4 Koblenz

DAY 5 Mannheim / Heidelberg

The enchanting UNESCO World Heritage City of Literature has inspired the likes of Mark Twain and famed British artist, William Turner.

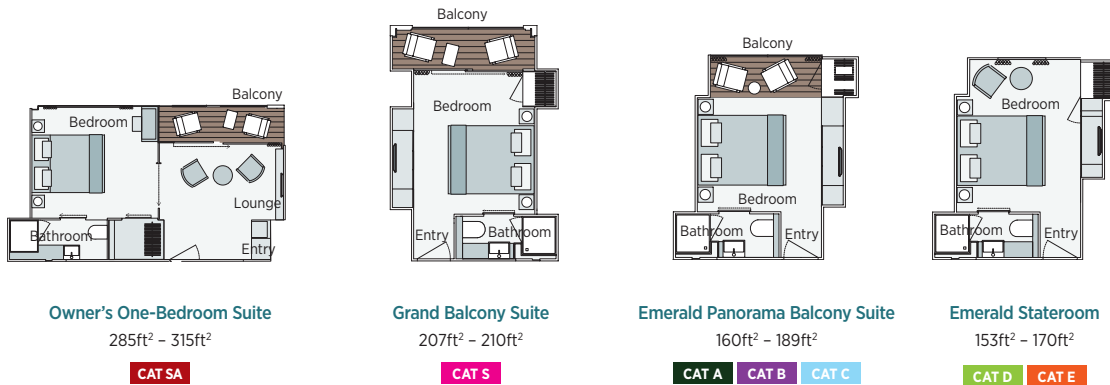
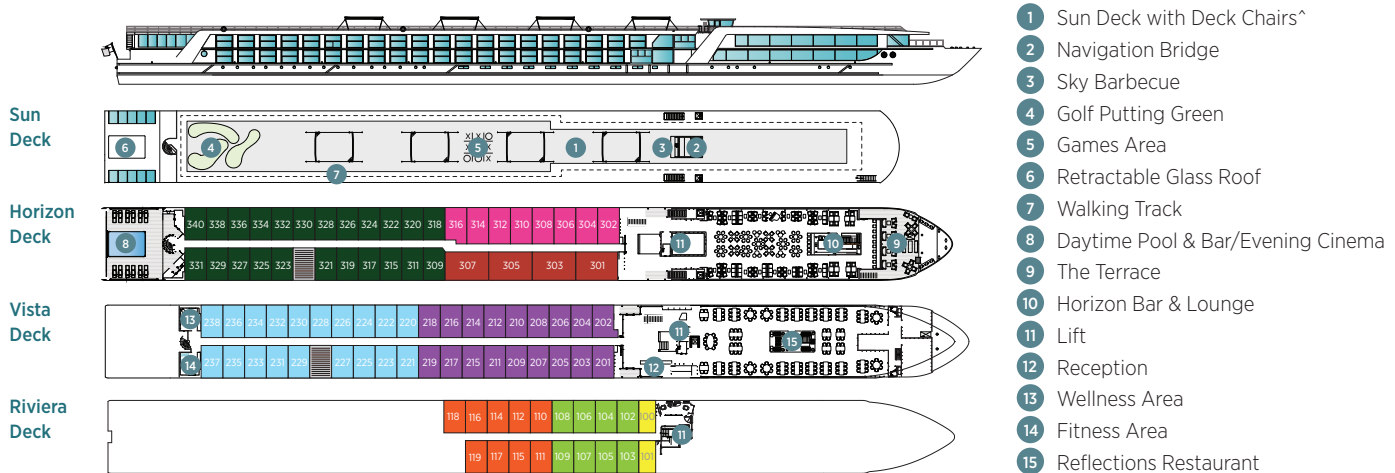
